Pray for your kids/others. (vs. 20-21a)

### How to pray for your kids:

- a. Salvation. (2 Peter 3:9)
- b. Character formation. (Galatians 5:22,23; Romans 8:29)
- c. Protection from harm. (Job 1:10, 1 Chronicles 4:10)
- d. Follow their God-given calling. (Ephesians 2:10, Exodus 2:2)
- e. God make them a blessing to others. (Genesis 12:3)
- f. Thank God for them. (Philemon 1:4)

## Believe the best for others. (vs. 21b)
